

CDU Traumatic Injury Inclusion/Exclusion Criteria

Exclusion Criteria

- 1. Depressed LOC <u>not</u> due to alcohol, drugs, or metabolic causes
- 2. Focal neurologic findings
- 3. Penetrating skull injuries
- 4. Depressed skull fractures
- 5. Positive CT scan
- 6. Signs of basilar skull fractures
- 7. Glasgow coma score less than 13
- 8. Age more than 70
- 9. Multiple medical problems
 - a. Bleeding disorders
 - b. Diabetes mellitus
 - c. Alzheimer's
 - d. Hemophilic
- 10. C spine injury
- 11. Respiratory instability

Clinical Decision Unit Interventions

- 1. Serial exams including vital signs
- 2. Serial neurologic exams
- 3. Analgesics

Disposition Criteria

- 1. Home
 - a. Normal serial exams
 - b. No deterioration in clinical course
- 2. Hospital
 - a. Deterioration in clinical course
 - b. Rule in of exclusionary causes or criteria

Time Frame

1. 24 hour observation
