

CDU Abdominal Pain Inclusion/Exclusion Criteria

Inclusion Criteria

- Undifferentiated abdominal pain needing further diagnostic evaluation, analgesia, antibiotics, IV fluids, and/or antiemetic.
- 2. Dehydration seconardary to vomiting/diarrhea or intractable symptoms for which intervention is indicated.

Exclusion Criteria

- 1. Fever over 103 degrees
- 2. Obstruction and infection
- 3. Sepsis
- 4. Acute Peritonitis
- 5. Systemic disorder
 - a. Renal Failure
 - b. DM
 - c. Sickle Cell disease
 - d. immunosuppression
- 6. Age over 65

Clinical Decision Unit Interventions

- 1. Serial exams including Vital Signs every 4 hours
- 2. Analgesic
- 3. Antipyretic
- 4. Antiemetic
- 5. IV hydration
- 6. Antimicrobial agents

Disposition Criteria

- 1. Home
 - a. DX of renal calculi
 - b. Pain control
 - c. DX if pyelonephritis without vomiting x 12 hours
 - D. Tolerate PO medications
- 2. Hospital
 - a. DX if renal calculi with UTI
 - b. Inability to control pain and N&V on PO medications
 - c. Pyelonephritis with inability to tolerate PO medications

Time Frame

1. 8 to 24 hours observation and treatment
